**SPECIAL SKILLS:** Must be competent using SQL and graphical business intelligence reporting tools to develop reporting and analytical solutions; SAP Business Objects highly preferred. Must understand relational database technology. Must have good analytical skills. Must be able to translate database schemas and business requirements into effective reporting solutions. Must be able to develop test cases and test plans to validate that reporting solutions meet business requirements. Must have good verbal and written communications skills, and be able to communicate effectively with technologists, architects, project managers, and IT management.

**DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:** The Data Warehouse (DW) Business Intelligence (BI) Developer is responsible for developing data reporting solutions using the SAP Business Objects platform and other technologies for the Enterprise Data Warehousing group in the Division of Enterprise Data Services within the New Jersey Office of Information Technology (OIT). This includes responsibility for design, development, testing, deployment, security, end-user training and support of solutions in a large enterprise environment representing more than two dozen subject areas supporting almost four thousand report users within State agencies. The DW BI Developer works with one or more project teams and may have responsibility for meeting deadlines for multiple overlapping assignments. The DW BI Developer shares in the responsibility with the other members of the project team for the quality of the data integrated and published by these solutions.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

**EDUCATION:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.

**EXPERIENCE:** One (1) year of programming, systems programming or computer analysis experience.

**NOTE:** Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience as indicated above on a year-for-year basis with thirty (30) semester hour credits being equal to one (1) year of experience.

**NOTE:** A Master's degree in an Information Technology field may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience.

**LICENSE:** Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a

vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform essential duties of the position.

**FOR NON-U.S. CITIZENS AND/OR FOREIGN DEGREES**

**AUTHORIZATION TO WORK:** U.S. Citizenship is not required. Selected candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. according to Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations.

**FOR FOREIGN DEGREES:** All non-U.S. degrees and/or transcripts from a college or university outside the U.S. must already be evaluated for accreditation and attached to your resume. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in ineligibility.

**RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:**

In accordance with the New Jersey First Act, [N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 \(L. 2011, Chapter 70\)](#), effective September 1, 2011 all employees must reside in the State of New Jersey unless exempted under the law. If you do not live in New Jersey, you have one year after you begin employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.
