N.J.A.C. 13:69-4.2 Determination of Confidential Status

This notice is to officially inform you that the Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division) has proposed to amend rules at N.J.A.C. 13:69 4.2 regarding the determination of confidential status. The proposed amendment specifies that casino gaming gross revenue information broken down by table game type and slot machine denomination shall be considered confidential information except as reported on an annual basis. This is a change from the prior policy of releasing such revenue figures monthly
