Petitioner, State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), located at 1300 Atlantic Avenue, Atlantic City, New Jersey, 08401 says:

1. Respondent, Crystal A. Lark ("Lark"), is an Ohio resident, and currently resides at [REDACTED]

2. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4 authorizes the exclusion of any person:

whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein, including

iii Persons who pose a threat to the safety of the patrons or employees of a casino licensee

iv. Persons with a documented history of conduct involving the undue disruption of the gaming operations of casino licensees

3. Lark has been arrested 7 times, each listed below, in 2010 and 2011. Of those arrests 6 took place in Atlantic City casinos.

A. July 2, 2012 arrest by the Atlantic City Police Department ("ACPD") and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, resulting in a 2 year barment from Tropicana.

B. August 1, 2010 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, resulting in a 2 year barment from Bally's.

C. September 12, 2010 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, resulting in a two year barment from Tropicana.

D. November 16, 2010 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, resulting in a 2 year barment from Tropicana.

E. November 27, 2010 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, where it

was alleged Lark was engaged in solicitation, resulting in a 2 year barment.

F. December 4, 2010 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Engaging in Prostitution, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1b, resulting in a fine and 8 days incarceration.

G. December 25, 2011 arrest by ACPD and subsequent conviction for Defiant Trespass, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3b, resulting in a 2 year barment from Harrah's.

4. Based on the information set forth in Paragraphs 1 though 3 of this Petition, Lark is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands the following relief against Respondent:


A. Judgment that Respondent, Crystal A. Lark, is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4; and

B. Judgment entering a final order placing Respondent, Crystal A. Lark, on the exclusion list pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71 and N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)4; and

C. Judgment for such other and further relief as the Director may deem just and appropriate under the circumstances.
