

("Anderson"), is a resident of New Jersey, having an address of [REDACTED]

2. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)3 provides, in pertinent, part for the exclusion of:

any person who has been convicted of a criminal offense.... punishable by more than six months in prison and whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey and of license gaming therein.

3. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4 authorizes the exclusion of

any person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein, including

iii Persons who pose a threat to the safety of the patrons or employee sof a casino licensee

iv. Persons with a documented history of conduct involving the undue disruption of the gaming operations of casino licensees

4. On March 12, 2012, Anderson was charged in Atlantic County Indictment No. 12-03-0244-D with 3 counts of Theft by Unlawful Taking, third degree, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3. Anderson allegedly stole a slot machine cash box containing \$580.00 from the Trump Taj Majal Casino Resort. On April 3, 2012, upon his plea, Anderson was convicted of one count of Theft by Unlawful Taking, third degree, contrary

to N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3. The remaining counts were dismissed. Anderson was sentenced to a 4 year term of probation and, further, required to pay certain fines and fees. Anderson was also ordered to stay out of all casinos during his probation term.

5. On September 8, 2010, Anderson was charged in Atlantic County Indictment No. 10-09-2072-DCP with Theft From the Person, third degree, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3. Anderson allegedly stole a voucher valued at \$365.50 from a patron of the Showboat Casino-Hotel. On February 3, 2012, upon his plea, Anderson was convicted of the amended offense of Theft From the Person, a Disorderly Persons offense, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3, and sentenced to an incarceration term of 180 days, and, further, required to pay certain fines and fees.

6. Between May, 1980, and January, 2006, Anderson was arrested on 21 separate occasions. These arrests led to convictions for Possession of CDS With Intent to Distribute, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), Theft by Unlawful Taking (4 occasions), contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3, Possession of CDS (3 occasions), contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10, Fraud, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:21-6, and Burglary, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-2. As a result of these convictions, Anderson was sentenced to varying terms of incarcerations, and various fines and fees.

7. Based on information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 6 of this petition, Anderson is a person who has been convicted of a criminal offense punishable by more than six months in prison and whose presence in a licensed casino establishment

would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey and of license gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)3.

8. Based on information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 6 of this petition, Anderson is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands the following relief against Respondent, Wayne E. Anderson, a.k.a. Matt More:

A. Judgment that the Respondent, Wayne E. Anderson, a.k.a. Matt More, is a person who has been convicted of an offense punishable by more than 6 months in jail and whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)3;

B. Judgment that the Respondent, Wayne E. Anderson, a.k.a. Matt More, is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)4;


C. Judgment entering a Final Order placing Respondent, Wayne E.

Anderson, a.k.a. Matt More, on the exclusion list pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71(l) and N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)3 and 13:69G-1.3(a)4; and,

D. Judgment for such other and further relief as the Director may deem just and appropriate under the circumstances.
