- (1) For purposes of the hands that qualify for payout for the Royal Baccarat Bonus wager:

- (1) For purposes of the hands that qualify for payout for the Royal Baccarat Bonus wager:
- 1. The rank of the cards, in order of highest to lowest rank, shall be: ace, king, queen, jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2. Notwithstanding the foregoing, an ace may be used to complete a "six card straight flush," formed with a 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, or a "straight flush" and a "straight" formed with a 2, 3, 4 and 5.

- 2. "Suit" shall mean one of the four categories of cards, that is, diamond, spade, club, or heart.
- 3. The hands recognized for payout for the royal baccarat bonus wager shall be:
- ii. "Six-of-a-kind" is a high hand consisting of six
  cards of the same rank;
- ii. "Six card straight flush" is a hand consisting
  of six cards of the same suit in consecutive ranking;
- iii. "Royal flush" is a hand consisting of an ace
  king, queen, jack and 10 of the same suit;
- ix. "Straight flush" is a hand consisting
  of five cards of the same suit in consecutive ranking;
- x. "Five-of-a-kind" is a hand consisting of five cards of the same rank;
- xi. "Four-of-a-kind" is a hand consisting of
  four cards of the same rank regardless of suit;
- xii. "Full house" is a hand consisting of a three-ofa-kind of one rank and a pair of another rank;
- xiii. "Flush" is a hand consisting of five cards of
  the same suit;
- ix. "Straight" is a hand consisting of five cards
  of consecutive rank, regardless of suit;
- x. "Three-of-a-kind" is a hand consisting of three cards of the same rank regardless of suit; and
- xi. "Two pair" is a hand consisting of two pairs, each pair consisting of two cards of the same rank, regardless of suit.

xii. "One Pair" is a hand consisting of two cards of the same rank, regardless of suit.

- 13:69F-7.10 Announcement of result of round; payment and collection of wagers
- (a) After each hand has received all the cards to which it is entitled pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69F-7.7, 7.8 and 7.9, the dealer shall announce the final point count of each hand indicating which hand has won the round. If the two hands have equal point counts, the dealer shall announce "Tie Hand." If the total card wagers authorized by N.J.A.C. 13:69F-7.2(a)4 are offered, the dealer shall also announce the total number of cards dealt during the round of play. In the no vigorish variation of mini-baccarat authorized by N.J.A.C. 13:69F-7.3(i), if a "dragon 7 hand" is dealt, the dealer shall announce "dragon 7." If the Royal Baccarat Bonus wager authorized by N.J.A.C. 13:69F-7.3(a)7 is offered, the dealer shall announce the hand that qualifies for the highest single payout formed from the cards dealt during the round of play.
  - (b) (e) (No change.)
- 13:69F-7.13 Additional rules for implementation of the Royal Baccarat

  Bonus wager in the progressive configuration
- (a) Prior to the first card being dealt for each round of play, each player may make a Royal Baccarat Bonus wager for a progressive jackpot by placing a wager at his or her betting position in conformity with the approved progressive wagering system. The amount of any progressive wager permitted by a casino licensee shall be

posted in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:69F-8.3. Once such wager has been placed, the dealer shall activate an approved progressive wagering system indicating that a progressive wager has been made at the appropriate betting position.

- (b) The dealer shall announce "No more bets" and register the progressive wagers on the progressive meter and reset the meter, if applicable. The dealer shall then proceed to deal the game and settle baccarat wagers and Royal Baccarat Baccarat Bonus wagers.
- (c) Prior to making a payout for a winning progressive bonus wager, the dealer shall:
  - 1. Verify that the player's hand is recognized for payout;
- Verify that the progressive wagering system has accepted the wager; and
- 3. Have a casino supervisor validate the progressive bonus wager payout pursuant to the casino licensee's internal controls.
- (d) All progressive bonus payouts that are 100 percent of the amount of the progressive meter shall be paid in accordance with the amount on the primary meter, with each such wagering player sharing equally in the total amount on the progressive meter regardless of the amount of the player's Royal Baccarat Bonus wager.
- (e) Whenever 100 percent of the amount on the progressive meter has been won, the cards for that round of play shall not be collected until the necessary documentation has been completed pursuant to the rules of the Division.
- (f) The rate of progression for any progressive meter or, if applicable, the reset meter and progressive meter combined, shall be

no less than 12%. The initial amount placed on any progressive meter by the casino licensee and portion of the reset amount funded by the casino licensee shall be established by each casino licensee in accordance with the rules of the Division.
