I have the following questions/comments on the proposed Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board Audit Questionnaire:

1. The questionnaire should be made as simple as possible as providing significant amounts of information/documentation takes away from billable time for the LSRP; particularly for small businesses.
2. Add a line on page 1 for existing or new contact information which will delete the need for the question on page 5.
3. I'm concerned that a current employer will potentially be damaged should an LSRP be found guilty of some wrong doings when they were an active LSRP at another firm regardless of their status at the new firm. The audit should focus on the LSRP at the firm they were employed at for the actions in question.
4. Section B: all of the information requested in 1-4 and 20 should be readily available from Data Minor.
5. Page 5: see comment #2 on the license update issue.
6. How does this relate to LSRP duties and responsibilities? LSRPs are not necessarily responsible for site health and safety, particularly if there is a designated Site Safety Officer or equivalent. If this question is necessary, is it possible to put a reasonable time limit on questions 2 and 3 (5 - 10 years)?
