

Portions of the questionnaire seems to be more like a renewal application with some of the questions (A1, Continuing Education, Update information). Furthermore, if we have CEU requirements, what if you get 32 hours over a 2 year period and have not taken any and plan to take them all in one week just prior to your license renewal? So what does answering that question do for anything except force you to admit you are a procrastinator.

Also, does the board have reciprocity agreements with other licensing agencies? I would be curious as to what penalties are spelled out based on reciprocity and what would constitute discipline of the LSRP during the audit (I am more worried about my LSRP affecting my PG license than the other way around).

KS [Kathi Stetser, Roux Associates] added comment - With the fear that the LSRP Board may be heavy handed (at least at first) I think LSRPS with licenses in other states are going to be concerned that any little something the LSRP Board takes action against will hurt them with their other licenses (because you have to answer questions when you renew your license for PE/PG etc. regarding any disciplinary actions. The LSRP Board needs to be clear when something rises to that level because a little smack for something not terribly troublesome could be a big problem in another state (we know this from experience).
