5A:9-1.2 Veterans' preference and veterans' status for pension purposes

(a) A person is entitled to veterans' preference or veterans' status for pension purposes, if he or she has been discharged or released from active United States military or naval service under conditions other than dishonorable, and has served in the active United States military or naval service during:

Operation "Uphold Democracy" in Haiti, commencing on or after September 19, 1994, and terminating on or before March 31, 1995, who served in Haiti or on board any ship actively engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a period, continuously, or in the aggregate, of at least 14 days, and who received an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal for such service. This military operation may only be used when establishing veterans' preference pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5A:9-1.4(a) and (b) and is not an applicable military operation for establishing veterans' pension pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5A:9-1.4(c), (d), or (e); or

A person is entitled to disabled veterans' preference if he or she:

Take notice that the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is adopting amendments and new rules in the Coastal Zone Management (CZM) Rules, Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act (FWPA) Rules, and Flood Hazard Area Control Act (FHACA) Rules to require electronic submission of applications for all general permit authorizations, individual permits, water quality certificates, freshwater wetland transition area waivers, and any flood hazard area verifications that are submitted in conjunction with an application for a general permit authorization, individual permit, or transition area waiver. These applications are required to be submitted through the "Apply for a Land Use Permit or Authorization" service (the electronic submission service), which can be accessed through the Department's electronic submission system, NJDEP Online.

Other amendments have been adopted to further streamline the rules and achieve greater consistency as part of the Department's continuing effort to align the three land use permitting programs to the extent possible and to clarify some existing application requirements to facilitate the submission of complete applications.

The Department is delaying the operative date for this adoption until October 5, 2021, to provide applicants with additional time to become familiar with the electronic submission service before use of the service becomes mandatory.
