TAG POLICY LETTER 03-7*

10 September 2003

BAN ON SMOKING IN DMAVA FACILITIES

1. Smoking in State-owned and/or operated buildings is prohibited by law. Similar bans prohibit smoking in Federal buildings and facilities that the New Jersey National Guard may use. Included in these bans are private offices, open work areas, hallways, lobbies, bathrooms, lunchrooms, and meeting rooms. Smoking is prohibited within fifty (50) feet of any DMAVA building.
2. Smoking is permitted only in specifically designated areas outside buildings. Station Commanders and/or Facility Managers will designate an area outside the building as a smoking area.
3. Smoking in the three Veterans Memorial homes is restricted to residents of the home. Residents may smoke only in a lounge approved by the home's Chief Executive Officer.
