TAG POLICY LETTER 12-7*

NON-DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY POLICY

- 1. This policy reinforces the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs commitment to the Americans with Disability Act of 1990 (ADA), which was signed into law by the President of the United States on 26 July 1990.
- 2. The Americans with Disabilities Act bars an employer from discriminating against qualified disabled persons. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission or access to, treatment or employment in, its programs or activities.
- 3. Ms. Loretta Sepulveda, Director, Human Resources Division, has been designated the State ADA Coordinator for the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, and will ensure compliance with non-discrimination requirements contained in 28 C.F.R. Section 35.107 of the Department of Justice regulations. Information concerning the provisions of the ADA and the rights thereunder are available from the State ADA Coordinator.
- 4. As the Adjutant General, I hereby state my personal commitment and support of the Americans with Disability Act of 1990.
