**STATE VEHICLES PARKING SUMMONSES (IASD-ASB)**

1. This bulletin applies to all DMAVA State employees who operate state vehicles.
2. The law concerning unpaid parking summonses was recently changed to allow the courts to suspend the registration of a vehicle with an outstanding summons. Previously, the law did not contain this provision. Now, upon second notice to the State of an unpaid parking ticket, the state government vehicle's registration will be automatically suspended until the summons is satisfied. A vehicle driven with a suspended registration is not legal in the State of New Jersey and exposes the driver to additional tickets and possible vehicle impound.
3. It is, therefore, imperative that all drivers of both individually assigned and/or pool fleet vehicles belonging to our agency act immediately on receipt of a summons. It is the driver's responsibility to resolve with the appropriate court all parking violations issued against vehicles assigned to them. Refer to Department Directive 451 dated 16 Mar 05, paragraph 9.1. and Department of Treasury Circular Letter 91-30-GSA.
4. Additionally, Supervisors must take immediate action when first notification is received by this Headquarters or Department of Treasury, Transportation Services of an unpaid summons notice for one of their employees ensuring timely resolution of violations issued against vehicles assigned to their employees.
