## UNITED STATES CODE

18 U.S.C. 641 Whoever embezzles, steals, purlions, or knowingly converts to his use or the use of another, or without authority, sells, conveys or disposes of any record voucher, money, or thing of value of the United States or any department or agency thereof, or any property made or being made under contract for the United States or any department or agency thereof; or

Whoever recieves, conceals, or retains the same with intent to convert it to his use or gain, knowing it to have been embezzeled, stolen, purlioned or converted,

Shall be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both; but if the value of such property does not exceed the sum of \$100, he shall be fined not more than \$1,000 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

The word "value" means face, par, or market value, or cost price, either wholesale or retail, whichever is greater.

## **NEW JERSEY STATUTES**

- N.J.S 38A:11-3 Every officer and enlisted member to whom public property has been or may hereafter be issued shall be financially and personally responsible to the state or to the United States, as their interest may appear, for its good condition, safe-keeping and return when called upon by the competent authority.
- N.J.S. 38A:14-2 Any person who shall secrete, sell, dispose of, offer for sale, purchase, retain after demand made by an officer or in any manner pledge or pawn any arms, equipment or other military property issued by the United States or this State for the use of the militia, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- N.J.S. 2A:85-7 Any person found guilty of a crime which by any statuate is declared to be a misdemeanor, and for which no punishment is specifically provided, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 3 years, or both.
