MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Three-Year Mobilization Deferment

- 1. The New Jersey Army National Guard (NJARNG) is offering a mobilization deferment for involuntary mobilization for a period of up to 36 months. The role of the NJARNG Soldier has become increasingly more demanding as we have transitioned from a strategic reserve to an operational force. Deferment for involuntary mobilization provides adequate transitioning time for Soldiers and stability for their families.
- 2. The following individuals who enlist into the NJARNG through one of the following enlistment programs will be authorized the 36-month stabilization from the date of separation or discharge.
- a. Active Duty Soldiers who transfer directly into the NJARNG through the Reserve Component Transition Program.
- b. Prior Service Soldiers who enlist into the NJARNG from the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR) provided that their last period of service was a period of 180 days or greater and in Title 10 status.
- c. Prior Service Soldiers without a Military Service Obligation (MSO) if the individuals break in service does not exceed 24 months and their last period of service was for a period of 180 days or greater and in a Title 10 status.
- 3. This stabilization policy does not apply to existing NJARNG members reenlisting in the New Jersey Army National Guard.
