**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2012-06**

I, Raymond P. Martinez, Chair and Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, as authorized pursuant to The Motor Vehicle Security and Customer Service Act, N.J.S.A. 39:2A-1, et seq., by N.J.S.A. 39:2-3, N.J.S.A. 39:3-4, and for good cause shown, do hereby order that, because Governor Chris Christie has declared a State of Emergency by Executive Order 104 (2012), and such executive order authorizes the waiver, suspension, or modification of any rule the enforcement of which would be detrimental to the public welfare during such State of Emergency, certain requirements concerning temporary registration certificates issued by the Motor Vehicle Commission are modified.

Specifically, the expiration date of any temporary New Jersey vehicle registration certificate shall be extended as set forth below:

1. The expiration date for any temporary New Jersey vehicle registration certificate (sometimes referred to as a "temp tag") that expires between November 1 and November 9, 2012, is extended until November 30, 2012.
2. Nothing in this Administrative Order shall be construed as restoring the driving and/or registration privilege of any person subject to a valid Order of Suspension as of the date of this Order, or any such suspension order subsequently imposed, and nothing in this Administrative Order shall be construed as permitting the operation of a motor vehicle without the automobile insurance required by law.
3. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as reducing the fees required to be paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, or upon inspection of a vehicle entitled to extension under the terms of this Order.
