

TITLE REQUIREMENTS

FOR INFORMATIONAL PURPOSES ONLY - DO NOT RETURN WITH COMPLETED APPLICATION

R.S. 39:10A-1. When a motor vehicle remains unclaimed by the owner or other person having a legal right thereto for a period of 20 days, it may be sold at auction in a public place.

Notice of sale by certified mail, return receipt requested, to owner, if known, and to holder of security interest, if any.

Notice of sale by publication, in a form prescribed by the Chief Administrator of the Motor Vehicle Commission by one insertion at least 5 days before the date of sale in one or more newspapers published in this state and circulating in the municipality in which such motor vehicle is held.

R.S. 39:10A-2. At any time prior to sale the owner or other person entitled to thereto may reclaim possession of the motor vehicle upon payment of the reasonable costs of removal and storage of the vehicle and any fine or penalty and court costs assessed against him for a violation which gave rise to the seizure or taking possession of such vehicle.
