


Need & Background

- Highlands Act and RMP direct Council to preserve land
 - Farmland, historic sites, outdoor recreation
- No comprehensive inventory of potential preservation projects
- No sense of community needs
- Capacity Grant with USFWS
- Request for Proposals Summer/Fall 2023
- 7 responses; 5 interviews





Land preservation is a vital means of natural resource protection





Project Details Identify and prioritize projects

- 8 tasks, 18 months
- Analysis of existing assets, stakeholder needs, goals, ranking system, funding plan
- Critical factors: environmental resources, economic sustainability, climate change, overburdened communities.
- Proactive approach to preservation in the Highlands.
