



# FEMA L950 NIMS ICS *All-Hazards Position Specific* Safety Officer

## Manheim, Pennsylvania

**June 9 – 12, 2015**

This course is designed to provide emergency first responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Safety Officer (SO) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). Instruction will be provided by two top-level EMI instructors: Chief Jimmie Smith and Chief Bill Shouldis.

### **Selection Criteria:**

NIMS ICS All-Hazards Position-Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to functional, support, or unit leader positions on a local or regional All-Hazard Incident Management Teams (IMT) or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions. This is a FEMA regional class and there are limited openings. This registration process IS NOT a first-come / first-served basis. Preference will be given to members of existing or developmental IMTs and members of an Emergency Operations Center or other Multiagency Coordination system entities.

### **Prerequisites:**

- IS/ICS-100, IS/ICS-200, ICS-300, and ICS-400
- IS-700 and IS-800.

Please have the application signed by your supervisor after he or she verifies completion of the course Prerequisites, scan it, and then e-mail it to Greg Noll per the directions below.
- Please ensure you list all prerequisites and dates completed on the FEMA 119-25-1, either in block 10 or on a supplemental page.
- All students who wish to enroll must have a student identification number (SID) in order to do so. The SID number replaces the social security number on the 119 application form, and no application can or will be processed without an SID number. To obtain an SID number, students should follow these instructions:
  - a. Step 1: To register, go to <https://cdp.dhs.gov/femasid/>
  - b. Step 2: Click on the "Need a FEMA SID" button on the right side of the page. The online system is designed for CDP applicants but works for NFA and EMI students as well.
  - c. Step 3: Follow the instructions and provide the necessary information to create your account.
  - d. Step 4: You will receive an email with your SID number. You should save this number in a secure location.
