

UTILITY INDUSTRY

The Energy Industry Fundamentals certificate program is a 49-hour course that provides an extensive overview of the energy industry to prepare individuals for occupation-specific training and pre-employment testing.

In order to receive the Energy Industry Fundamentals (EIF) credential, all modules must be completed, and students must take and pass an assessment. The modules for the program include:

- Basic and emerging principles and concepts that impact the energy industry
- Compliance with procedures necessary to ensure a safe and healthy work environment
- Electric power generation
- Electric power and natural gas transmission
- Electric and natural gas distribution

Minimum Requirements for Employment Opportunities:

- HS Diploma or GED; 9th grade level for reading and math
- Drug-free
- Valid driver's license
- Interest in craft/technician work
- Enjoy physical labor and outdoor work
- Experience in craft/technician or similar work (including other industries) is desirable
