TO: ALL NEW JERSEY LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AND SECURITY AGENCIES

The New Jersey State Police Private Detective Unit will begin accepting applications for Security Agency Licenses on April 8, 2007, as required by the Security Officer Registration Act. Only electronic applications and electronic payments will be accepted.

A person seeking a Security Agency License shall submit with each application, a non-refundable application fee and surcharge of \$250.00 and \$50.00 respectively. Applicants shall submit fingerprints and a written consent for a criminal history background check to the Superintendent, as required by N.J.A.C. 13:55A-2.2.

N.J.A.C.13:55A-2.1 requires all applicants must meet the following licensing requirements:

- (a) All owners and operators of a security officer agency seeking to be licensed shall be at least 25 years of age.
- (b) All owners and operators of a security officer agency seeking to be licensed shall have the following:
 1. Five years law enforcement experience and no longer be employed or attached in any capacity whatsoever to a law enforcement agency; or
 2. Five years of experience working in a supervisory or management capacity for a security officer company licensed under this chapter, the "Private Detective Act of 1939" or the laws of any other jurisdiction.



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
