NOBWLE “NO BULLIES” 2015 BULLY PREVENTION POSTER CONTEST Entry Rules and Evaluation Methods

- Any student enrolled in a public, parochial or private elementary, middle school or High school in the United States of America may participate in The NOBWLE “NO BULLIES” 2015 Bully Prevention Poster Contest.
- Contest period October 15, 2015 to November 15, 2015.
- Completed poster size must be 11” x 17” or 12” x 18”(no larger). Posters may be vertical or horizontal.
- Any weight of paper is permitted.
- There is no limitation on the use and number of colors.
- There is no limitation on the type of media -- such as print, crayon, felt pen, etc. -- used on the poster design; however, wood, plastic, glass or metal should not be part of the poster.
- Poster designs may not incorporate any copyrighted characters (i.e., comic and/or television characters), photographs, and magazine or newspaper illustrations.
- Drawings must be original and the exclusive work of the student entering the contest in idea, design and execution. All artwork should be positive in approach, expressing your ideas on bullying prevention.
- Every poster and slogan must harmonize with the poster contest theme: NOBWLE “NO BULLIES” Program! (Contestants must illustrate above theme only.)
- The best way to send the poster is flat, between taped sheets of cardboard. Do not send posters rolled in a tube. Please send posters using a method that lends itself to easy opening with a razor (this will help keep the poster from being damaged during opening).
- Be sure posters are not wrapped so securely that opening becomes a challenge. Do not use duct tape or large amounts of tape.
- In submitting a poster, students agree that the poster may be displayed at NOBWLE Newark Chapter meetings, featured in its publications, and included on its web site.
- All posters and related intellectual property rights become the property of the National Organization of Black Women in Law Enforcement (NOBWLE) Newark Chapter upon receipt and are not returned to the artist, his/her

parents/legal guardians, art instructor, school, state or contest sponsor, or any other person(s) claiming a right, title or other interest in the poster.

- Students may work individually or in teams. The maximum number of students per team is three.
- Complete the poster competition entry form.
- There must be a 3" x 5" card/entry blank securely fastened to the back of the poster which includes the student's name, grade, grade category (K-3, 4-6, 7-9, or 10-12), age, teacher's name, school name and school address. Please print clearly. Do not place name, school, etc., on the front of the poster. Display information on the back only.
- Your poster needs to be postmarked by November 15, 2015 to the address below. There is no entry fee. Do not send posters rolled in a tube.
- Winners will be notified personally November 30, 2015.
- NOBWLE Newark Chapter has the right to disqualify any entry that does not comply with all contest requirements.
- Prizes will be awarded for each division as follows:
 - Grade category:
 - K – 3
 - 4 - 6
 - 7 – 9
 - 10 - 12
- The overall winning posters will be used to promote National Bully Prevention in 2016!!

 - Originality of the poster and how the idea is expressed in the poster design. (Originality)
 - Artwork and its execution. (Artistic Quality)
 - Visual impact of the poster design. (Visual Impact)
