#### **DGE Announces February 2013 Casino Win Results**

ATLANTIC CITY —

Based upon filings with the Division of Gaming Enforcement, total casino win was \$212.3 million in February 2013 compared to \$242.7 million last February. The 12.5% change is partially attributed to there being one less day in February 2013, since last February had 29 days due to the leap year. Table game win was \$67 million, reflecting an increase of 0.9% compared to the prior period. Slot machine win was \$145.3 million, reflecting a variance of 17.6% due in part to the impact of a \$9.8 million, or 28%, reduction in promotional gaming credits wagered compared to the same period last year.

Casinos paid \$15.5 million in taxes on their gross revenues in February. That money, 8 percent of taxable gross revenue, goes into the Casino Revenue Fund, which pays for programs that benefit qualifying senior citizens and people with disabilities. In addition, the casino industry incurred \$2.6 million in reinvestment obligations based on their gross revenues for the month. Casinos are required to reinvest 1.25 percent of gross revenues in projects approved by the Casino Reinvestment Development Authority.

For the first two months of the year, casinos won \$418 million reflecting a change of 12.9% from the same period in 2012.

Win reflects the net amount of money won by casinos. It is not profit.
