DUTIES: Under direction of an Administrator of Investigations in the Division of Gaming Enforcement, Department of Law and Public Safety, assists in performing specific field and office work relative to financial, compliance, and enforcement functions, applicants for gaming licensure or criminal and civil violations of other state statutes; investigates and audits casino Information Technology operating systems; assesses the interoperability between the multiple Information Technology systems used in the casinos; will perform assessment of a casino operating system's ability to record and track revenue activity.

REQUIREMENTS
