Petitioner, State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety,  
Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), located at 1300 Atlantic Avenue, Atlantic City,  
New Jersey, 08401 says:

1. Respondent, EUGENE M. GUNTHER ("Gunther"), is a New Jersey resident, residing at [REDACTED]

2. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4 authorizes the exclusion of

any person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein, including

iii Persons who pose a threat to the safety of the patrons or employee sof a casino licensee

iv. Persons with a documented history of conduct involving the undue disruption of the gaming operations of casino licensees

3. On May 4, 2012, Gunther was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Gunther reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On August 17, 2012, Gunther was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Gunther was barred from Bally's Atlantic City for a period of two years.

4. On June 6, 2012, Gunther was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Gunther reentered Resort's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On July 20, 2012, Gunther was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Gunther was barred from Resort's Atlantic City for a period of two years.

5. On October 2, 2013, Gunther was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Gunther reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On November 19, 2013, Gunther was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court and fined. This arrest violated a previous barment order entered by the Atlantic City Municipal Court.

6. On October 8, 2013, Gunther was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Gunther reentered Tropicana Hotel Casino and Resort after having been previously evicted. On November 19, 2013, Gunther was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court and fined.

7. Based on information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 6 of this Petition, Gunther is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands the following relief against Respondent, Eugene M. Gunther:

A. Judgment that Respondent, Eugene M. Gunther, is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C. 13:69G-

1.3(a)4;

B. Judgment entering a final order placing Respondent, Eugene M. Gunther, on the exclusion list pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71 and 13:69G-1.3(a)4 and,

C. Judgment for such other and further relief as the Director may deem just and appropriate under the circumstances.
