Petitioner, State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety,  
Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), located at 1300 Atlantic Avenue, Atlantic City,  
New Jersey, 08401 says:

1. Respondent, JAZZMAN S. BLACK ("Black"), is a New Jersey resident, residing at [REDACTED]

2. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4 authorizes the exclusion of any person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein, including

iii Persons who pose a threat to the safety of the patrons or employee sof a casino licensee

iv. Persons with a documented history of conduct involving the undue disruption of the gaming operations of casino licensees

3. On January 18, 2011, Black was arrested and charged with Engaging in Prostitution, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1B(1). Black offered to engage in sexual intercourse with an undercover detective for \$180 at the Taj Majal Hotel and Casino. On June 13, 2011, Black was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court and fined.

4. On May 19, 2011, Black was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Black reentered Trump Taj Majal Casino and Resort after having been previously evicted. On June 13, 2011, Black was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Black was barred from entering Trump Taj Majal Casino and Resort for a period of two years.

5. On October 2, 2011, Black was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Black reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On October 13, 2011, Black was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Black was barred from entering Bally's Atlantic City for a period of two years.

6. On April 14, 2012, Black was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Black reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. Black also violated a previous barrment order, dated October 13, 2011. On May 17, 2013, Black failed to appear in Atlantic City Municipal Court, and a warrant was issued for her arrest.

7. Based on information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 6 of this Petition, Black is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands the following relief against Respondent, Jazzman S. Black:

A. Judgment that Respondent, Jazzman S. Black, is a person who has been convicted of an offense punishable by more than 6 months in jail and whose

presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)3;

B. Judgment that Respondent, Jazzman S. Black, is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4;

C. Judgment entering a final order placing Respondent, Jazzman S. Black, on the exclusion list pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71 and N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)3; 13:69G-1.3(a)4 and,

D. Judgment for such other and further relief as the Director may deem just and appropriate under the circumstances.
