PETITION FOR
PLACEMENT ON
EXCLUSION LIST

Petitioner, State of New Jersey, Department of Law and Public Safety,
Division of Gaming Enforcement ("Division"), located at 1300 Atlantic Avenue, Atlantic City,
New Jersey, 08401 says:

1. Respondent, THOMAS TROLIO A.K.A. THOMAS PATRICK IROLIO,
A.K.A. JAMAL DAVIS ("Trolio"), is a resident of [REDACTED]



2. N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4 authorizes the exclusion of

any person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein, including

iii Persons who pose a threat to the safety of the patrons or employee sof a casino licensee

iv. Persons with a documented history of conduct involving the undue disruption of the gaming operations of casino licensees

3. On November 27, 2008, Trolio was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Trolio reentered Trump Plaza Hotel and Casino after having been previously evicted. On December 18, 2008, Trolio was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court.

4. On December 15, 2008, Trolio was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Trolio reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On January 7, 2009, Trolio was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Trolio was barred from Bally's Atlantic City for a period of two years.

5. On November 14, 2011, Trolio was arrested and charged with Simple Assault, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1a(1). 8-3. Trolio spit on a security officer at the Trump

Plaza Hotel and Casino. On November 21, 2011, Trolio was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court.

6. On May 28, 2012, Trolio was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Trolio reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On January 7, 2009, Trolio was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. In addition to other penalties, Trolio was barred from Bally's Atlantic City for a period of two years.

7. On December 26, 2012, Trolio was arrested and charged with Criminal Trespass, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3. Trolio reentered Bally's Atlantic City after having been previously evicted. On April 22, 2013, Trolio was convicted of this offense in Atlantic City Municipal Court. This offense violated the prior debarment orders issued against Trolio.

8. Based on information contained in Paragraphs 1 through 7 of this petition, Davis is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interests of the State of New Jersey or licensed gaming therein and should be excluded from casino premises pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:69G-1.3(a)4.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner demands the following relief against Respondent,
Thomas Trolio:


A. Judgment that the Respondent, Thomas Trolio, is a person whose presence in a licensed casino establishment would be inimical to the interest of the State of New Jersey or of licensed gaming therein, within the meaning of N.J.A.C.13:69G-1.3(a)4;

B. Judgment entering a Final Order placing Respondent, Thomas Trolio, on the exclusion list pursuant to N.J.S.A. 5:12-71(l) and 13:69G-1.3(a)4; and,

C. Judgment for such other and further relief as the Director may deem just and appropriate under the circumstances.
