Description

This training course offers crash investigator insight into the operational function of the Bosch Crash Data Retrieval (CDR) System. At the end of the training, a technician is expected to image and preserve data in a format that the “CDR Data Analyst” would be able to use together with evidence to complete reconstruction. Although the CDR Technician course replaces a portion of the previously offered “CDR Operator's Certification Course”, it does *not* address any analysis of the extracted/ data. The one day course is best suited for field/on-scene investigators; it is also required as a prerequisite for the CDR Data Analyst's course. If you have already attended an Analyst and/or Technician course, the training will serve as a much needed update on new vehicles, software, and additional storage modules that are added every year.

NOTE: Ownership of a CDR System is encouraged, but not required for the training. The training design is such that even those who have not yet obtained a system will better understand this evolving technology and benefit from the information. Course completion meets the requirements for recognition as a Bosch CDR System Data Collection Technician.
