

Need Help with the Child Passenger Safety Technician (CPST) Re-Certification process?

The certification cycle for Child Passenger Safety Technicians and Instructors is two years. In order to retain your certification, you must meet all of the requirements and successfully complete the re-certification process. Certification ensures you remain up to date with skills in this constantly changing discipline.

There are three general steps to successful re-certification:

1. Meet all pre-registration requirements, including:
 - Verified seat check activity (5 seat types verified by an Instructor)
 - Community event (one check up event or community education activity)
 - Continuing Education Units (6 hours).
2. All completed requirements must be entered into your online SafeKids profile. Not sure how to access your profile – go to <http://www.safekids.org/CERTIFICATION/faq.html> or call customer service at (877) 366-8154.
3. Register and pay for re-certification (this may be done up to four months prior to your certification cycle end date, but not after your expiration date).

PLEASE NOTE: The re-certification process cannot be completed in a single day. Depending upon the choices you make, the process could take as few as five days to as many as 60 days to complete.
