INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

SHARON ROBERTS

between on or about December 23, 2000, and on or about August 11, 2001, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said SHARON ROBERTS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$5,208 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said SHARON ROBERTS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said SHARON ROBERTS

then and there well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and N.J.S.A. 2C: 20-2b(4), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

SHARON ROBERTS

between on or about December 15, 2001, and on or about July 27, 2002, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said SHARON ROBERTS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$8,932 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said SHARON ROBERTS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said SHARON ROBERTS then and there well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and N.J.S.A. 2C: 20-2b(4), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE


(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)

SHARON ROBERTS

on or about August 3, 2002, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which she did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said SHARON ROBERTS did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 30074030 dated July 31, 2002 containing a false statement that the said SHARON ROBERTS did report all holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks ending July 20, 2002 and July 27, 2002, and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


