INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

WALTER KING

between on or about December 8, 2001, and on or about August 31, 2002; at the Town of Hammonton, in the County of Atlantic elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said WALTER KING did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$12,607 by creating or reinforcing the false impression to the State of New Jersey that the said WALTER KING was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said WALTER KING then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and N.J.S.A. 2C: 20-2b(2) (a), and

against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of  
the same.

COUNT TWO

(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)


WALTER KING

on or about August 5, 2002, at the Township of Hammonton, in the County of Atlantic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said WALTER KING did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 30062010, dated July 30, 2002, containing a false statement that the said WALTER KING did report all earnings and holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks ending July 13, 2002 and July 20, 2002 and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
