INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

PATRICK W. PERSICANO

between on or about March 8, 2003, and on or about August 22, 2003, at the City of Somerville, in the County of Somerset, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said PATRICK W. PERSICANO did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits by creating or reinforcing the false impression to the State of New Jersey that the said PATRICK W. PERSICANO was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said PATRICK W. PERSICANO then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary


to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and N.J.S.A. 2C: 20-2b(4), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)


PATRICK W. PERSICANO

on or about August 22, 2003, at the City of Somerville, in the County of Somerset, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said PATRICK W. PERSICANO knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 35376586 dated August 19, 2003, containing a false statement that the said PATRICK W. PERSICANO met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the week ending August 9, 2003 and August 16, 2003, the said check bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


