INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(False Contract Payment Claims for a
Government Contract - Second Degree)

JAMES E. HAAS, JR.

between on or about August 4, 2006 and on or about August 10, 2006, in the Township of Moorestown, and in the Township of Southampton, in the County of Burlington, and in the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly submit to the government a claim for payment for performance of a government contract of \$25,000 or above knowing such claim to be false, fictitious, or fraudulent, that is, JAMES E. HAAS, JR., did knowingly submit a claim for payment of \$25,000 or more to Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., a contractor for the New Jersey Department of Transportation Southard Street Bridge

Project, Trenton, for the removal of soil from the Southard Street Bridge Project, and disposal of said soil at an approved disposal facility, as required under Neshaminy Constructors, Inc. contract and supplementary agreement with the New Jersey Department of Transportation, when JAMES E. HAAS, JR. knew the soil from that project had been disposed of at or near 400 Hartford Road, Moorestown, which was not an approved disposal facility, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34a and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Falsifying Records - Fourth Degree)


between on or about August 7, 2006 and on or about August 10, 2006, in the Township of Moorestown, and in the Township of Southampton, in the County of Burlington, and in the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, with the purpose to deceive another, or injure another or to conceal wrongdoing, did utter a writing or record knowing it contained false information, that is JAMES E. HAAS, JR., with the purpose to deceive Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., or to conceal wrongdoing from Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., did submit to Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., a bill of lading dated August 7, 2006 for a truckload of soil that identified the destination for the truckload as "BCLF", Burlington County Landfill, an approved disposal facility, when the ultimate destination for the truckload of soil was a location at or near 400 Hartford Road, which was not an approved disposal facility, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4a and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Falsifying Records - Fourth Degree)

JAMES E. HAAS, JR.

between on or about August 7, 2006 and on or about August 10, 2006, in the Township of Moorestown, and in the Township of Southampton, in the County of Burlington, and in the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, with the purpose to deceive another, or injure another or to conceal wrongdoing, did utter a writing or record knowing it contained false information, that is JAMES E. HAAS, JR., with the purpose to deceive Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., or to conceal wrongdoing from Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., did submit to Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., a Haas Sand and Gravel Co., Inc. weigh ticket, number 14213, for "Shoreline #931," dated August 7, 2006 for Neshaminy Constructors, Inc., "Southard Street Trenton - NJDOT", representing a truckload of material brought to an approved disposal facility, when he well knew that said weigh ticket was not from an approved disposal facility, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:21-4a and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


