

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey,
upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft By Deception-Third Degree)

LONZO W. YOUNG

between on or about March 24, 2002, and on or about September 26,
2004, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere,
and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain
by deception property of the State of New Jersey valued in excess
of \$500; that is, the said LONZO W. YOUNG did purposely obtain
unemployment insurance benefits by submitting or causing to be
submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits to the
State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false
impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said LONZO W.
YOUNG was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said LONZO W. YOUNG
then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the


provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, N.J.S.A. 2C:20-2b(2) (a) and
against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of
the same.


COUNT TWO

(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)

LONZO W. YOUNG

on or about April 13, 2004, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said LONZO W. YOUNG did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 38326417, dated April 13, 2004, containing a false statement that the said LONZO W. YOUNG did report all earnings and holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks ending April 3, 2004 and April 10, 2004 and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
