INDICTMENT

KENAN YILMAZ )

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey,  
upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Bribery - Second Degree)

KENAN YILMAZ

between on or about January 23, 2008, and on or about March 3,  
2008, at the Township of Medford, in the County of Burlington,  
elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly  
did directly or indirectly offer, confer, or agree to confer upon  
another a benefit as consideration for the violation of an  
official duty of a public servant, or for the performance of an  
official duty; that is, the said KENAN YILMAZ did offer, confer,  
or agree to confer upon an employee of the New Jersey Motor  
Vehicle Commission, a benefit in excess of \$200 or more, as  
consideration for a violation of an official duty, or performance  
of an official duty, by issuing New Jersey Motor Vehicle  
Commission Driver Licenses, contrary to the provisions of

N.J.S.A. 2C:27-2(c) and (d), and against the peace of this State,  
the government and dignity of same.

COUNT TWO

(Attempted Tampering with Public Records or Information -  
Third Degree)

KENAN YILMAZ

on or about February 4, 2008, at the Township of Medford, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose to defraud or injure, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing, or use any record, document or thing, knowing it to be false, and with the purpose that it be taken as a genuine part of the information or records belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government; that is, the said KENAN YILMAZ, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing or use, a New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission Application for a New Jersey Driver License and other identifying and pedigree information of the purported applicant, Mesut Ersoz, which information was submitted to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-7a(2) and N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Attempted Tampering with Public Records or Information -  
Third Degree)

KENAN YILMAZ

on or about February 26, 2008, at the Township of Medford, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose to defraud or injure, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing, or use any record, document or thing, knowing it to be false, and with the purpose that it be taken as a genuine part of the information or records belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government; that is, the said KENAN YILMAZ, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing or use, other identifying and pedigree information of the purported applicant for a New Jersey Driver License, Sahin Hasan, which information was submitted to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-7a(2) and N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR


(Attempted Tampering with Public Records or Information -  
Third Degree)

KENAN YILMAZ

on or about February 26, 2008, at the Township of Medford, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose to defraud or injure, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing, or use any record, document or thing, knowing it to be false, and with the purpose that it be taken as a genuine part of the information or records belonging to, or received or kept by, the government for information or record, or required by law to be kept by others for information of the government; that is, the said KENAN YILMAZ, did attempt to make, present, offer for filing or use, other identifying and pedigree information of the purported applicant for a New Jersey Driver License, Serdar Canpolat, which information was submitted to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-7a(2) and N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
