v.

JOHN THOMAS-EL

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Attempted Murder - First Degree)

JOHN THOMAS-EL

on or about July 24, 2007, in the City of Camden, County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did attempt to purposely cause the death of Detective Sergeant Mark Cunard, and/or Detective William Stolinski, and/or Detective Joseph Loschiavo, in that, while fleeing from police, the said JOHN THOMAS-EL did fire a .25 caliber handgun at or in the direction of Detective Sergeant Mark Cunard, Detective William Stolinski, and Detective Joseph Loschiavo, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3(1), and N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1., and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Aggravated Assault - Second Degree)

JOHN THOMAS-EL

on or about July 24, 2007, in the City of Camden, County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did attempt to cause serious bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon, in that, he did fire a .25 caliber handgun at Detective Sergeant Mark Cunard, Detective William Stolinski, and Detective Joseph Loschiavo, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1b(1), and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

JOHN THOMAS-EL

on or about July 24, 2007, in the City of Camden, County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly or purposely obtain, possess, actually or constructively, a controlled dangerous substance, or its analog, classified in Schedule I, II, III, or IV, that being, the said JOHN THOMAS-EL did possess PCP, (Phencyclidine), contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10.1, and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose - Second Degree)

JOHN THOMAS-EL


on or about July 24, 2007, in the City of Camden, County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did have in his possession, a firearm, that being, a .25 caliber handgun, with purpose to use it unlawfully against the person or property of another, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4a(1), and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Resisting Arrest - Third Degree)


JOHN THOMAS-EL

on or about July 24, 2007, in the City of Camden, County of Camden, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did purposely prevent or attempt to prevent a law enforcement officer from effecting an arrest by the use of physical force or violence against the law enforcement officer, in that the said JOHN THOMAS-EL did fire a .25 caliber handgun at Detective Sergeant Mark Cunard, and/or Detective William Stolinski, and/or Detective Joseph Loschiavo, while trying to effect an arrest, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2a(3), and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.





JOHN THOMAS-EL




