upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(False Contract Payment Claims, Representation,  
for a Government Contract-Second Degree)

GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR.

and

VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC.

between on or about October 4, 2006 and on or about September 5,  
2007, at the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer,  
elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly  
did make a material misrepresentation that was false in  
connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a  
government contract valued in excess of \$25,000; that is the  
said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC.

knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that the Public Works Contractor Registration was valid by submitting or causing to be submitted an altered certificate in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract with Bergen Engineering Company, in the amount of \$98,500;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. then and there well knew, the Public Works Contractor Registration was revoked, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34b, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(False Contract Payment Claims, Representation,  
for a Government Contract-Second Degree)

between on or about October 16, 2006 and on or about September 5, 2007, at the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that was false in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract valued in excess of \$25,000; that is the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that the Public Works Contractor Registration was valid by submitting or causing to be submitted an altered certificate in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract with Brockwell & Carrington Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$46,000;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. then and there well knew, the Public Works Contractor Registration was revoked, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34b, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(False Contract Payment Claims, Representation,  
for a Government Contract-Second Degree)

between on or about May 31, 2006 and on or about September 5, 2007, at the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that was false in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract valued in excess of \$25,000; that is the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that the Public Works Contractor Registration was valid by submitting or causing to be submitted an altered certificate in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract with Terminal Construction Corporation, in the amount of \$195,000;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. then and there well knew, the Public Works Contractor Registration was revoked, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34b, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 against the peace of this State, the

government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(False Contract Payment Claims, Representation,  
for a Government Contract-Second Degree)

GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR.

and

VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC.

between on or about August 30, 2006 and on or about September 5, 2007, at the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that was false in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract valued in excess of \$25,000; that is the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that the Public Works Contractor Registration was valid by submitting or causing to be submitted an altered certificate in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract with Prismatic Development Corporation, in the amount of \$150,000;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. then and there well knew, the Public Works Contractor Registration was revoked, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34b, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(False Contract Payment Claims, Representation,  
for a Government Contract-Third Degree)

GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR.

and

VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC.

between on or about May 23, 2006 and on or about September 5, 2007, at the Township of Ewing, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that was false in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract valued in excess of \$2,500 but less than \$25,000; that is the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. knowingly did make a material misrepresentation that the Public Works Contractor Registration was valid by submitting or causing to be submitted an altered certificate in connection with the negotiation, award or performance of a government contract with Monmouth Construction, LLC, in the amount of \$23,000;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said GEORGE M. VANICKO, JR., and VANKO PAINTING/COATING, INC. then and there well knew, the Public Works Contractor Registration was revoked,

all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-34b, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


