

B. One or more of them knowingly would aid in the planning, solicitation, or commission of said crime, that is:

1. Knowingly to use force upon another, in the course of committing a theft, while armed with a deadly weapon, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:15-1(a).

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Robbery - First Degree)

RAUL GONZALEZ

LEVERNE MCDOWELL

and

ERIC RIVERA

on or about February 28, 2008, at the City of Paterson, in the County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, in the course of committing a theft, knowingly did use force upon G.C., while armed with a deadly weapon, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:15-1(a) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Burglary - Second Degree)

RAUL GONZALEZ

LEVERNE MCDOWELL

and

ERIC RIVERA

on or about February 28, 2008, at the City of Paterson, in the County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did enter the structure located at 353 Paxton Street, with purpose to commit an offense therein, and in the course of committing the said offense were armed with a deadly weapon, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-2 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Unlawful Possession of a Weapon - Second Degree)

RAUL GONZALEZ

LEVERNE MCDOWELL

and

ERIC RIVERA

on or about February 28, 2008, at the City of Paterson, in the County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did possess a certain weapon, that is, a Raven silver .25 caliber handgun, serial number 243876, without having first obtained a permit to carry same as provided in N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5(b) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose - Second Degree)

RAUL GONZALEZ

LEVERNE MCDOWELL

and

ERIC RIVERA

on or about February 28, 2008, at the City of Paterson, in the County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did possess a certain firearm, that is, a Raven silver .25 caliber handgun, serial number 243876 with purpose to use it unlawfully against the person or property of another, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4(a), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIX

(Possession of a Weapon by a Convicted Person - Second Degree)


RAUL GONZALEZ

on or about February 28, 2008, at the City of Paterson, in the County of Passaic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, having been convicted of the crime of burglary, on Passaic County Indictment Number 96-04-00424-I, and having been convicted of the crime of burglary, on Passaic County Indictment Number 03-05-00447-I, did purchase, own, possess or control a Raven silver .25 caliber handgun, serial number 243876, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
