#### COUNT ONE

(Theft By Deception-Second Degree)

#### TERRANCE GIVENS

on or about March 10, 2005, at the City of Plainfield, in the County of Union, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception property of another in an amount of \$75,000 or more; that is, the said TERRANCE GIVENS did purposely obtain \$200,000 from New Century Mortgage Company, by creating or reinforcing a false impression on a mortgage loan application that the information on the loan application was accurate, namely that, he was employed by Wall Designs, Inc.;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said TERRANCE GIVENS then and there well knew, he was not employed by Wall Designs,

Inc., and the information on the loan application was false, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, N.J.S.A. 2C:20-2b(2)(a) and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
