The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy - Second Degree)

TUAN DANG

NGOC BUI

and

THU NUGYEN

between on or about January 1, 2007, and on or about February 20, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, at the Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, at the Townships of Monroe and Old Bridge, both in the County of Middlesex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court,

with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crimes of maintaining or operating a controlled dangerous substance production facility, manufacturing a controlled dangerous substance, and distribution of a controlled dangerous substance, did agree that:

- A. One or more of them knowingly would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or
- B. One or more of them knowingly would aid in the planning, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:
- 1. Knowingly or purposely to maintain or operate a controlled dangerous substance production facility, used for the manufacture of marijuana in an amount greater than five pounds or ten plants, or knowingly to aid, promote, finance, or otherwise participate in the maintenance or operations of such premises, place or facility, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-4.
- 2. Knowingly or purposely to manufacture a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of fifty or more marijuana plants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(10).
- 3. Knowingly or purposely to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of twenty-five pounds or more including any adulterants or dilutants,

contrary to the provisions of $\underline{N.J.S.A.}$ 2C:35-5a(1) and $\underline{N.J.S.A.}$ 2C:35-5b(10).

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Leader of Narcotics Trafficking Network - First Degree)

TUAN DANG

between on or about January 1, 2007, and on or about February 20, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, at the Townships of Millstone, Manalapan, and Middletown, all in the County of Monmouth, at the Townships of Monroe and Old Bridge, both in the County of Middlesex, at the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did conspire with others as an organizer, supervisor, financier or manager, to engage for profit in a scheme or course of conduct to unlawfully distribute, dispense, bring into or transport in this State controlled dangerous substances, that is, marijuana, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-3, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Maintaining or Operating a Controlled Dangerous Substance Production Facility - First Degree)

Monroe Township, New Jersey, used for the manufacture of

marijuana in an amount greater than five pounds or ten plants, or

knowingly did aid, promote, finance, or otherwise participate in

the maintenance or operations of such premises, place or

facility, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-4 and

N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the

government and dignity of the same.

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

between on or about September 1, 2008, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Monroe, in the County of Middlesex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of twenty-five pounds or more including any adulterants or dilutants, that is, approximately fifty pounds of processed marijuana, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(10)(a), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

available only for compensation, by deception or other means,

that is, by obtaining electricity by bypassing the service

provider's electric meter to 558 Spotswood-Englishtown Road,

Monroe Township, New Jersey, to avoid payment for service,

contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-8a, N.J.S.A.

2C:20-2b(2)(a), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of

this State, the government and dignity of the same.

dignity of the same.

COUNT NINE

(Manufacturing a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

between on or about January 1, 2009, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Old Bridge, in the County of Middlesex, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did manufacture a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of fifty or more marijuana plants, that is, six hundred and forty marijuana plants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(10)(a), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Second Degree)

(Maintaining or Operating a Controlled Dangerous Substance Production Facility - First Degree)

COUNT FIFTEEN

(Theft of Services - Third Degree)

between on or about July 25, 2008, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of theft of services, in that said TUAN DANG and NGOC BUI purposely did obtain services, that is, electricity service, having a value in excess of \$500.00, which the said TUAN DANG and NGOC BUI knew to be available only for compensation, by deception or other means, that is, by obtaining electricity by bypassing the service provider's electric meter to 38 South Robbins Road, Millstone, New Jersey, to avoid payment for service, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-8a, N.J.S.A. 2C:20-2b(2)(a), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIXTEEN

(Criminal Mischief - Third Degree)

TUAN DANG

and

NGOC BUI

between on or about July 25, 2008, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Millstone, in the County of Monmouth, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely or recklessly did tamper with the tangible property of another, that is, real property located at 38 South Robbins Road, Millstone, New Jersey, owned by T.W. and S.W., so as to endanger the property of T.W. and S.W., causing a pecuniary loss of \$2,000.00 or more, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:17-3a(2), N.J.S.A. 2C:17-3b(1), and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SEVENTEEN

(Maintaining or Operating a Controlled Dangerous Substance Production Facility - First Degree)

TUAN DANG

between on or about July 1, 2009, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did maintain or operate, a premise, place or facility, that is, a residence located at 535 Beach Avenue, Manahawkin, New Jersey, used for the manufacture of marijuana in an amount greater than five pounds or ten plants, or knowingly did aid, promote, finance, or otherwise participate in the maintenance or operations of such premises, place or facility, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-4, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT EIGHTEEN

(Manufacturing a Controlled Dangerous Substance - First Degree)

between on or about July 1, 2009, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did manufacture a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of fifty or more marijuana plants, that is, four hundred and sixty four marijuana plants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(10) (a), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance - Third Degree)

between on or about July 1, 2009, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of one ounce or more including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(10)(b), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Theft of Services - Third Degree)

between on or about July 1, 2009, and on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely or recklessly did tamper with the tangible property of another, that is, real property located at 535 Beach Avenue, Manahawkin, New Jersey, owned by D.B. and K.B., so as to endanger the property of D.B. and K.B., causing a pecuniary loss of \$2,000.00 or more, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:17-3a(2) and N.J.S.A. 2C:17-3b(1), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWENTY-TWO

(Money Laundering - Second Degree)

between on or about January 1, 2007, and February 18, 2010, at the Township of Stafford, in the County of Ocean, at the Townships of Millstone, Manalapan, and Middletown, all in the County of Monmouth, at the Townships of Monroe and Old Bridge, both in the County of Middlesex, at the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did transport or possess property known or which a reasonable person would believe to be derived from criminal activity, or did engage in transactions involving property known or which a reasonable person would believe to be derived from criminal activity with the intent to facilitate or promote the criminal activity, in an amount greater than \$75,000 in U.S. currency, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-25a, N.J.S.A. 2C:21-25b, N.J.S.A. 2C:21-27a, and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWENTY-THREE

(Bribery in Official Matters - Second Degree)

TUAN DANG

on or about February 18, 2010, at the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did directly or indirectly offer, confer or agree to confer a benefit as consideration for a violation of an official duty of a public servant, that is, the said TUAN DANG did offer between \$100,000 and \$150,000 in U.S. currency to Detective Christopher Wright, of the New Jersey State Police, in exchange for his release and the release of NGOC BUI, both of whom were under arrest and in the lawful custody of the New Jersey State Police, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:27-2(c), and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
