THIS MATTER being brought before the Court by the State of New Jersey, Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP"), seeking relief pursuant to the Solid Waste Management Act, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1, et seq. ("SWMA") and the Flood Hazard Area Control Act, N.J.S.A. 58:16A-50, et seq. ("FHACA"); New Jersey common law of nuisance, and R. 4:52 and R. 4:67-1(a), based upon the facts set forth in the Verified Complaint filed herewith; and the Court having determined that this matter may be commenced by Order to Show Cause pursuant to the SWMA, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-1, et seq., the FHACA, N.J.S.A. 58:16A-50, et seq., the common law, and R. 4:52 and R. 4:67-1(a); and the Court having further determined that the SWMA provides that the Court may proceed in a summary manner pursuant to N.J.S.A. 13:1E-9(d), and that considerations of judicial economy persuade the Court that it may also proceed in an expedited manner as to the FHACA, N.J.S.A. 58:16A-63, nuisance, and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 14 day of March 2011, ORDERED that TRI STATE SUPPLY, LLC, AL JR. ENTERPRISES, LLC, ALLAN J. ROMBOUGH, JR., INDIVIDUALLY, SUMMER FREITAS, INDIVIDUALLY, FCI CONTRACTING, LLC, C. FEIJOO TRUCKING, ANDRADE'S TRANSPORTATION, INC., DEPINO TRANSPORTATION, INC., ALL AROUND TRUCKING, INC., HUNTER-ATLANTIC, INC., ZELIA TRUCKING, JAYM TRANS., LLC, J. FLORES, LLC, DELGADO 2 TRUCKING, INC., RM TUIT PAVING, LONG ISLAND

CONCRETE, INC., and JOHN DOES 1 - 10 (hereinafter "the DEFENDANTS"), appear and show cause on the 15 day of April, 2011, before the Superior Court at the Passaic County Courthouse, Paterson, New Jersey, at 9 o'clock^{am}, or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an Order should not be entered:

(a) Permanently and/or preliminarily enjoining and restraining the DEFENDANTS from continuing to violate the SWMA and the regulations promulgated thereto by placing and storing solid waste fill material in the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers in Wayne Township and ordering Defendants to remove all such solid waste fill material;

(b) Permanently and/or preliminarily enjoining and restraining the DEFENDANTS from violating the FHACA and the regulations promulgated thereto by placing and storing solid waste fill material in the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers in Wayne Township, and ordering Defendants to remove all such solid wastes fill material;

(c) Permanently and/or preliminarily enjoining and restraining the DEFENDANTS from maintaining a public nuisance, to wit: the deposit and placement of solid waste fill material in the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers, said fill material which unreasonably interferes with the health, safety and welfare of the

, citizens of Wayne Township by increasing the threat of flood damage to citizens, property owners and businesses in the Township;

(c) Ordering the DEFENDANTS, within seven (7) days of the return date of this Order, to submit to the DEP, Bureau of Coastal Land Use Enforcement, a plan for the DEP's approval which describes how DEFENDANTS will remove all the solid wastes and fill material from the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers, consistent with DEP regulations;

(d) Ordering the DEFENDANTS to begin removal of all fill material in the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers within seven (7) days of DEP's approval of a plan submitted pursuant to subparagraph (c) of this Order;

(e) Ordering the DEFENDANTS to completely remove all solid wastes and fill material in the floodway of the Ramapo and Pompton Rivers, consistent with DEP regulations, no later than 120 days from the date DEP approves a plan submitted pursuant to subparagraph (c) of this Order;

(f) ordering payment by the DEFENDANTS of costs of the Department's investigation, inspection, and/or monitoring surveys which led to the establishment of the violations, and for the reasonable costs of preparing and bringing this legal action; and

(g) granting such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

1. A copy of this order to show cause, Verified Complaint and all supporting affidavits or certifications submitted in support of this application be served upon the DEFENDANTS by personal service, certified mail or other means allowed by the Rules of the Court, within 7 days of the date hereof, in accordance with R. 4:4-3 and R. 4:4-4, this being original process.
2. The Plaintiff must file with the court its proof of service of the pleadings on the DEFENDANTS no later than three days before the return date.
3. The DEFENDANTS shall file and serve a written opposition to this Order to Show Cause and the relief requested in the Verified Complaint, and proof of service of the same, by April 5, 2011. The opposition papers must be filed with the Clerk of the Superior Court in the county listed above and a copy of the papers must be sent directly to the chambers of Judge McVeigh.
4. The Plaintiff must file and serve any written reply to the DEFENDANTS' opposition by April 11, 2011. The reply papers must be filed with the Clerk of the Superior Court in the county listed above and a copy of the reply papers must be sent directly to the chambers of Judge McVeigh.


5. If the DEFENDANTS do not file and serve opposition to this Order to Show Cause, the application will be decided on the papers on the return date and relief may be granted by default, provided that the plaintiff files a proof of service and a proposed form of order at least three days prior to the return date.

FEIJOO TRUCKING, ANDRADE'S TRANSPORTATION, INC., DEPINO TRANSPORTATION, INC., ALL AROUND TRUCKING, INC., HUNTER-ATLANTIC, INC., ZELIA TRUCKING, JAYM TRANS., LLC, J. FLORES, LLC, DELGADO 2 TRUCKING, INC., RM TUIT PAVING, LONG ISLAND CONCRETE, INC., and JOHN DOES 1 - 10 take notice that the Plaintiffs have filed a Verified Complaint against you in the Superior Court of New Jersey. The Verified Complaint attached to this Order to Show Cause states the basis of the lawsuit. If you dispute this Complaint, you or your attorneys must file a written Answer and Proof of Service within 35 days of service of the Verified Complaint upon you. These documents must be filed with the Clerk of the Superior Court for Passaic County, Chancery Division. Include a filing fee payable to the "Treasurer State of New Jersey." You must also send a copy of your Answer to the Plaintiff's attorneys. A telephone call will not protect your rights; you must file and serve your Answer or judgment may be

entered against you by default. Please note that any opposition to the Order to Show Cause DOES NOT constitute an Answer to the Verified Complaint. You must file both. If you do not file and serve an Answer within 35 days of the service of this Order and the Verified Complaint upon you, the Court may enter a default against you for the relief the Plaintiff demands.

7. If you cannot afford an attorney, you may call the Legal Services office in the county in which you live. A list of three offices is provided. If you do not have an attorney and are not eligible for free legal assistance, you may obtain a referral to an attorney by calling one of the Lawyer Referral Services. A List of these numbers is also provided.

8. The Court will entertain argument, but not testimony, on the return date of the Order to Show Cause, unless the court and parties are advised to the contrary no later than 3 days before the return date.

It will be considered contempt in the face of the Court if Defendants RM TUIT & Sons, Zelia Trucking, FCI Contracting, LLC, Depino Transportation Inc., Citozi Express, Inc., Beltran Contractors, Inc., and Milton Chiles Trucking, LLC further deliver any product, hazardous material, or fill to the Site at issue.
