NOW THEREFORE, it is on this

agreed between the parties heretofore mentioned that:

- 1. The named Respondent shall continue to comply with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq.
- 2. Respondent agrees to assist in facilitating a training program for the Cab Drivers of Atlantic City in cooperation with the City of Atlantic City (Mercantile Department) in making know to the Cab Drivers the 'law' both Federal (ADA) and State (LAD) and their individual obligations under the law. The Division on Civil Rights will provide the training and the Respondent will work to facilitate the training between the DCR and the City of Atlantic City. While disability and the use of "Guide Dogs" will be a major focus, all areas of Harassment Prevention will be discussed. The Division on Civil Rights is to monitor. The above conditions shall represent full satisfaction of all alleged claims of damages arising out of this matter.
- 3. Respondent and Complainant agree not to engage in any retaliatory conduct against each other or any participant in these proceedings nor will the Respondent allow any of its dispatchers to engage in any such conduct.
