Synthetic Marijuana Use



Cases of individuals being exposed to synthetic marijuana, as reported to New Jersey's poison control hotline, have declined by 33 percent.

From March 1 through August 31, 2012, the New Jersey Poison Education & Information System (NJPIES) received a total of 46 calls from emergency rooms, doctors' offices, and private residences, about individuals who knowingly or otherwise ingested synthetic marijuana – compared with a total of 69 cases during the same six-month period in 2011.
