The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy-Second Degree)

FRANK RIZZO

MICHAEL KOUVARAS

and

DEUTERON CAPITAL, LLC

SOUTH STREET FILLIT RECYCLING

between on or about August 6, 2010, and on or about March 28, 2011, at the Township of Riverside, in the County of Burlington, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crimes of Unlawful Release of a Toxic Pollutant and Violation of the

Asbestos Control and Licensing Act, did conspire and agree that:

- A. One or more of them would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or an attempt or solicitation to commit such crimes; or
- B. One or more of them would aid in the planning, attempt, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:
- 1. Unlawful Release of a Toxic Pollutant, in that they would purposely or knowingly cause the unlawful release of a toxic pollutant, asbestos, a listed toxic pollutant under N.J.A.C. 7:14 Appendix A Table V, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:17-2a(2);
- 2. Abandonment of Toxic Pollutants, in that they would purposely or knowingly cause the unlawful abandonment of bags containing asbestos, a listed toxic pollutant under N.J.A.C. 7:14A-4 Appendix A Table V, contrary to N.J.S.A 2C:17-2a(2);
- 3. Violation of the Asbestos Control and Licensing Act, in that they would knowingly perform, directly or indirectly, asbestos removal without first obtaining a license from the Commissioner of Labor to perform such work, as required by N.J.S.A. 34:5A-36, contrary to N.J.S.A. 34:5A-41;

All in violation of the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, N.J.S.A. 2C:2-7 and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

(Violation of the Asbestos Control and Licensing Act - Third Degree)
