TO: SECURITY OFFICER INSTRUCTOR APPLICANTS

The New Jersey State Police, Private Detective Unit will be offering a 40-hour certification training course for applicants seeking to become a certified Security Officer Instructor in accordance with the Security Officer Registration Act (SORA). This is the sixth course of its kind and will be held at the New Jersey State Police Technology Complex, 1200 Negron Drive, Hamilton, New Jersey 08691. Course hours and dates are as follows:

All applications and requisite fees must be submitted electronically via the internet: http://njsp.org/about/pd-soraupdates.html After making application electronically, applicants will then be required to email the Private Detective Unit (pdu@gw.njsp.org) with their name and application ID number to reserve a seat in the class. All applicants must, on the first day of class, bring proper identification. This identification must include a photo, name, address, and date of birth. Examples of acceptable identification include:

- 1) Photo drivers license or photo ID issued by any State DMV or MVC.
2) Passport and/or immigration ID.
3) Federal, State, County, Municipal employment ID.
