TO: ALL NEW JERSEY BOUNTY HUNTERS AND/OR FUGITIVE RECOVERY AGENTS.:

The New Jersey State Police, Private Detective Unit will be offering a 16-hour "Bounty Hunter Training Course" in accordance with the Bounty Hunter Licensing Act. This training will be given at the Middlesex County Fire Academy, 1001 Fire Academy Drive, Sayreville, NJ 08872. The training course will consist of two (2) 8-hours days, 8am - 4pm, on the following dates:

Monday, June 22, 2009  
Tuesday, June 23, 2009

Only bounty hunter applicants utilizing the requisite experience exemption provided in N.J.A.C. 13:55B-2.5 are required to attend this training. Notification will be sent to the email address listed within the applicant's profile.

### **Acceptable ID:**

Only current photo identification issued by Federal, State, County or Municipal entities for identification purposes will be accepted. This identification must include a current photo, name, address (home/employer) and date of birth. Examples of acceptable identification include 1) Photo driver's license or photo ID issued by any State DMV or MVC, 2) Passport or Immigration ID, 3) Federal, State, County, Municipal employment ID.

New Jersey licensed bounty hunters or current bounty hunter applicants may also attend this training course. Seating is limited and priority will be given to those applicants required to attend. Anyone wishing to attend this training course must reserve a seat by contacting the New Jersey State
