The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon

their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy-Second Degree)

JOSE BURGOS

JEFFREY DELACRUZ

FRANCISCO DELACRUZ

and

ANGEL TIRADO

between on or about June 12, 2001, and on or about August 29, 2001, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crimes of receiving stolen property, fencing, and possession of motor vehicles with altered vehicle identification numbers, did agree together and with other persons whose identities are known to the Grand Jurors, who are named as coconspirators but not as defendants in this Indictment, that:

A. One or more of them would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or

B. One or more of them would aid in the planning, solicitation or commission of said crimes, that is:

1. Knowingly or purposely receiving or bringing into the State movable property of others knowing the same to be stolen or believing that it had probably been stolen, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-7;

2. Knowingly or purposely trafficking in, initiating, organizing, planning, financing, directing, managing, or supervising trafficking in stolen property, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-7.1b; and

3. Knowingly or purposely for an unlawful purpose,

possessing a motor vehicle, or parts thereof, from or on which a trademark, distinguishing or identification number, serial number or mark had been removed, covered, altered, changed, defaced, destroyed or obliterated, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:17-6b.

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Receiving Stolen Property - Second Degree)

between on or about June 12, 2001, and on or about August 29, 2001, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did commit theft by knowingly receiving or bringing into the State movable property of others, that is, a 1991 Volkswagen Cabriolet, VIN WVWCB5150MK002288, the property of John R. Nichols having an approximate value of \$4,000; a 1989 Volkswagen Cabriolet, having all of its vehicle identification numbers removed, having an approximate value of \$4000; a 1989 Ford Mustang, having an approximate value of \$1,175; a 2001 Honda Civic, VIN 1HGEM22921L072918, the property of Alex Perez having an approximate value of \$17,385; a 1995 Acura Integra, VIN JH4DB7660SS008475, the property of Amercian Honda Finance Corporation having an approximate value of \$10,300; a 1990 Toyota Camry, VIN 4T1SV21E5LU234207, the property of Urande F. Silva having an approximate value of \$4,460; a 1998 Toyota Camry, VIN JT2SV21E2J3228106, the property of Marie G. Louis having an

approximate value of \$4,115; a 1991 Honda Accord Wagon, VIN 1HGCB9869MA014050, the property of Carlos M. DaSilva having an approximate value of \$7,350; a 2000 Honda Civic, VIN 1HGEG6677YLO08439, the property of Norma J. Santiago having an approximate value of \$14,365; a 1992 Honda Civic, VIN 1HGEG8658NL047397, the property of Zhijian Zhou having an approximate value of \$6,160; a 1995 Honda Civic, VIN JHMEH9695SS012954, the property of Ermalinda Matos having an approximate value of \$7,835; a 1998 Acura Integra, VIN JH4DB8591WS000344, the property of Ewan Walden having an approximate value of \$15,675; a 1995 BMW 325i convertible, VIN WBABJ53285JC84443, the property of Jakki Taylor having an approximate value of \$18,550, with the above referenced movable property having an aggregate value of approximately \$105,370, knowing the same to be stolen or believing that it had probably been stolen, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-7 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Fencing - Second Degree)

JEFFREY DELACRUZ

FRANCISCO DELACRUZ

and

ANGEL TIRADO

between on or about June 12, 2001, and on or about August 29, 2001, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly or purposely traffic in, initiate, organize, plan, finance, direct, manage, or supervise trafficking in stolen property, having an aggregate value of \$75,000 or more, that is, motor vehicles, including a 1991 Volkswagen Cabriolet, a 1989 Volkswagen Cabriolet, a 1989 Ford Mustang, a 2001 Honda Civic, a 1995 Acura Integra, a 1990 Toyota Camry, a 1998 Toyota Camry, a 1991 Honda Accord Wagon, a 2000 Honda Civic, a 1992 Honda Civic, a 1995 Honda Civic, and a 1998 Acura Integra, all as more specifically identified in Count Two of this Indictment, having an aggregate value of approximately \$96,820, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-7.1b and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession of Motor Vehicles with Altered Vehicle
Identification Numbers - Third Degree)




between on or about June 12, 2001, and on or about August 29, 2001, at the City of Newark, in the County of Essex, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did, for an unlawful purpose, possess motor vehicles from or on which a trademark, distinguishing or identification number, serial number or mark had been removed, covered, altered, changed, defaced, destroyed or obliterated, the said motor vehicles having had a value in excess of \$500, that is, the said JOSE BURGOS, JEFFREY DELACRUZ, FRANCISCO DELACRUZ and ANGEL TIRADO knowingly did possess a 1989 Volkswagen Cabriolet, having all of its vehicle identification numbers removed, having an approximate value of \$4000; and a 1989 Ford Mustang, having an altered vehicle identification number, having an approximate value of \$1,175,

contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:17-6b and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of the State, the government and dignity of the same.
