



eligibility

- The crime must have occurred in New Jersey or a New Jersey resident victimized outside of the State.
- The victim must have reported the crime to police within 9 months*
- The victim must cooperate with the investigation and prosecution of the crime
- The claim must be filed within 3 years of the date of the crime*
- Must be an innocent victim of crime

** Consideration will be taken if good cause exists for delayed filing*

items needed to process claim

- Completed NJ VCCO Application
- Police Report
- Copies of bills, receipts and all documentation of losses

benefits provided \$25,000 maximum

mental health counseling

- Homicide Survivor(s) up to \$12,500
- Injured Victim up to \$12,500
- Secondary Victim(s) up to \$7,000

medical services

- Medical bills incurred by victim not covered by other sources
- Chiropractor/Physical Therapy
- Medical Supplies and/or Prescription Drugs
- Transportation for victim's treatments

Loss of earnings

- Up to \$600 per week
- Temporary disability not to exceed 24 months
- Permanent disability not to exceed 60 months
- Secondary victim loss of earnings*
- Bereavement not to exceed two weeks*
- Court attendance*

Loss of financial support *

- Up to \$600 per week
- Not to exceed 48 months

other

- Funeral Costs up to \$5,000
- Transportation to Funeral up to \$1,000 at \$200/person
- Crime Scene Cleanup up to \$4,000
- Relocation Expenses up to \$2,500
- Domestic Help/Child Care/Day Care Services up to \$6,500
- Victims' Rights Attorney Fees up to \$3,000 at \$125/hour
- Attorney fees for representing victim with VCCO claim up to 15% of award at \$125/hour

catastrophic injuries

Supplemental \$35,000 for:

- Rehabilitative Services
- Home modifications up to \$15,000
- Vehicle modifications
