  - You can decide at any time to exercise these rights and not answer any questions or make any statements.

## INFORMATION FOR INNOCENT VICTIMS OF CRIME

- You may file for compensation for medical/counseling expenses and for lost wages from crime-related injuries (\$25,000 maximum). In the case of the death of a victim, funeral expenses of up to \$5,000 may be paid by the Victims of Crime Compensation Office.
- You may be eligible for emergency financial assistance.
- You may request referrals to counseling, shelters and other emergency services.
