DIRECTIVE #6-1994

Effective March 1, 1994, the following will be the cancellation policy of the New Jersey Racing Commission:

- 1) All Mutuel tickets with a total value of \$500 or less may be cancelled at any window at any time prior to post-time.
- 2) All Mutuel tickets with a <u>total value exceeding</u> \$500 may be cancelled by the mutuel manager or designee as approved by this Commission. All such requests, whether approved or disapproved, must be reported to this Commission within 48 hours using a form approved by this Commission.
- 3) It shall be the responsibility of the mutuel manager or designee as approved by this Commission to determine if the approval of a cancellation request will considerably alter or manipulate a mutuel pool. Several factors should be considered, including the size of the mutuel pool, reason for the requested cancellation, current odds, minutes to post, and any late changes such as track conditions, etc.
- 4) This directive applies to all wagers placed on live or common pool races.
- 5) Copies of this cancellation policy shall be placed in all programs and should also be prominently displayed throughout the wagering area.
- 6) Any attempt to violate this policy or to attempt to manipulate a wagering pool may be considered conduct detrimental to racing.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT OUR CURRENT POLICY IS STILL IN EFFECT FOR ADVANCE WAGERS AND THOSE WAGERS THAT ARE NOT DISPLAYED IN THE FORM OF PROBABLE ODDS. (CURRENTLY DAILY TRIPLE, TRIFECTA, PICK-6 AND PICK-7)
