

**DIRECTIVE NO. 5 - 2006**

As a result of a change in law effective May 26, 2006, the Racing Commission hereby  
directs the following:

**Effective immediately**, notwithstanding the provisions of any rule within Chapters 13:70 and 13:71 to the contrary, upon application of a permitholder, the Racing Commission in its discretion may provide that the minimum wager amount that may be placed on a horse race may be \$0.10 or greater. In considering such applications, the Racing Commission shall approve the request where it determines that such approval will be consistent with the best interests of racing, where the totalisator system is capable of processing such wager, and where such approval will not create confusion to the wagering public. In approving such application, the Racing Commission may impose such conditions as it deems appropriate. Where such a wager is approved for a permitholder and where otherwise consistent with law, the Racing Commission upon application may also approve the offering of such wager at Atlantic City Casino simulcast facilities.
