**Notice of Action (Final) on Petition for Rulemaking**

Off-Track and Account Wagering

N.J.A.C. 13:74

Petitioner: Lewis Stein

Take notice that on February 23, 2017, the New Jersey Racing Commission received a petition for rulemaking from Lewis Stein requesting that the Commission adopt a new rule permitting New Jersey residents to place wagers with the New Jersey Account Wagering system while a resident is temporarily outside the State of New Jersey. A Notice of Receipt of Petition for Rulemaking was published in the New Jersey Register on May 15, 2017 at 49 N.J.R. 1260(a).

Take notice that on April 21, 2017, the Commission took action with regard to the above-described petition and determined to refer the matter for further deliberations which shall be concluded within 90 days of the referral so that the matter may be placed before the Commission for consideration at a public meeting.

Take further notice that on July 19, 2017, the New Jersey Racing Commission duly considered the petition pursuant to law and took Final Action. At that time, the New Jersey Racing Commission denied the petition based upon legal advice, as approval would be inconsistent with the existing law which requires the system to be an intra-state system.
